Key Data Concepts & Terminologies

Data Governance: Establish policies & procedures to ensure data quality, consistency, & security across the organization. Ensure data accuracy & reliability for users of the data.

Data Integration: Combine data from various sources into a unified view to enhance accessibility & usability.

Data Warehousing & Data Lakes: Store large volumes of data in a centralized repository for efficient querying & analysis.

Data Analytics: Implement advanced analytics to extract insights & support decision-making.

Data Security: Protect data from breaches & unauthorized access through robust security measures.

Master Data Management (MDM): Maintain a single, consistent view of critical business data across the organization.

Data Privacy & Security: Ensure compliance with data privacy regulations & protect sensitive information.

Data Lifecycle Management: Manage data throughout its lifecycle, from creation to deletion. Ensure data management practices are in place to monitor the data lifecycle.

Data Monetization: Leverage data as an asset to generate revenue & create business value. Creating the value proposition of data usage within the organization.


Data Virtualization: Access & manipulate data without needing to know its physical location or format. Visuals representing the data within the repository for easier user experience.

Pillar Two Data Strategy

- Many organizations already have a data strategy with short-term & long-term goals to meet Pillar 2 requirement. Some have opportunities to use Pillar Two as a catalyst to incorporate a broader data strategy into their organization.
 Below are a few key concepts to keep in mind when thinking about your Pillar Two data strategy & compliance readiness:
 - **Centralized Data Management**: Consolidate tax data in one warehouse for ease of data access, transparency, & increased accuracy.
 - Automation: Use technology & cloud computing to automate data processes.
 - Compliance: Develop a framework for accurate Pillar 2 compliance & reporting.
 - Security: Implement strong data security policies aligned with your broader organization's data security management.
 - **Training**: Equip tax professionals with necessary skills & knowledge.
 - Value Proposition: Identify & calculate economics on the value of the overall data strategy for Pillar 2 & beyond.





Pillar Two Data Challenges



Data Points by Detailed Calculation Category







Key Data Point Concerns

Can financial reporting provide the detail needed by jurisdiction & CE?

- Need for legal entity/CE & transaction-level detail
- Loss of details in consolidation (differing COAs at lower-level ERP systems)

Do consolidated workpapers exist & are they accessible by tax? Is additional cleansing or transformation of the data required?

- Transfer pricing & CbCR data
- I/C transactions & eliminations
- Purchase accounting Where are the PPAs recorded? Can they be pushed down?

Do separate workpapers need to be created for GloBE & how will they be maintained?

- GloBE income new book to GloBE adjustments
- Deferreds, Tax Payment, GloBE election(s)

How will the data be gathered, where will it be stored, who will be the data owners, & can the master data be used for other purposes?

- Can/should any portion be pushed back into finance?
- Is there a broader data strategy or transformation initiative your team should be working with?



Initial Pillar Two Data Analysis



Understand Broader Data Strategy & Organizational Initiatives

- Analyze the organizations current data strategy & any transformation or system implementations that could impact your data collection & warehousing process.
- Determine how Pillar Two will fit into the current data strategy & how any modifications will be incorporated.



Evaluate Data Requirements & Assess Current Data Accessibility

- Conduct a thorough assessment of the data requirements necessary for comprehensive analysis.
- Evaluate the current state of data visibility & accessibility across all relevant systems.



Identify & Address Potential Data Gaps

- Identify any potential gaps in the data gathering process that may impact your analysis.
- Develop strategies to address & mitigate these gaps effectively.



Determine Pillar Two Data Strategy

Identify process & procedures around data gathering, data management, transformation, & controls specific to Pillar Two.





Document & Ensure Stakeholder Buy-In

Pillar Two Tax Data Readiness Checklist

- Can you leverage Pillar Two data requirements for other tax, or even non-tax, needs within your organization?

- If third-party advisors will be responsible for Pillar Two compliance & reporting, have you determined how they will access the required data?
- If transformation is required, have you considered what tools you might have available in your organization to assist with the required transformation?
- Have you established & documented the roles & responsibilities around your Pillar Two process?
- Have you aligned your organizations broader data strategy with your Pillar Two & general tax data strategy?
