Contract Type

- The type of contract can impact how a transaction should be taxed & who bears the burden & reporting responsibility
 - Lump Sum v. Time & Materials
 - Repair v. New Install
 - Commercial v. Residential
 - TPP v. RP

Understanding Differences Among States

- While there are general rules that apply among many states, there are also several states that have very nuanced rules overall or for specific activities. Examples include:
 - Mississippi Contractor's Tax
 - Arizona Transaction Privilege Tax
 - North Carolina & New York (repair & maintenance services)



Overview of SALT Challenges (cont.)

Contractors That Are Most Impacted

- Contractors routinely entering new jurisdictions where they have never operated
- Contractors providing a variety of services that may have varying tax treatment
- Contractors serving special industry customer types:
 - Manufacturers
 - Nonprofits
 - Government agencies
